The very first bill **Governor Sununu** ever signed into law allows dangerous individuals to legally carry hidden, loaded weapons. **Senators James Gray** (R-Rochester) and **Harold French** (R-Franklin) supported this measure; Senator **Bob Giuda** (R-Warren) was a bill sponsor.
