The very first bill **Governor Sununu** ever signed into law allows dangerous individuals to legally carry hidden, loaded weapons. **Senators Jeb Bradley** (R-Wolfeboro) and **Bob Giuda** (R-Warren) sponsored this bill. Both Senators also refused to ban dangerous bump stocks or support gun free school zones.

**Senators Jeff Woodburn** (D-Whitefield) and **Martha Hennessey** (D-Hanover), however, supported public safety on each of these votes.
