The very first bill **Governor Sununu** ever signed into law allows dangerous individuals to legally carry hidden, loaded weapons. **Senators Chuck Morse** (R-Salem), **Kevin Avard** (R-Nashua), **Andy Sanborn** (R-Bedford), **Ruth Ward** (R-Stoddard), and **Gary Daniels** (R-Milford) supported this measure, as well as refused to ban dangerous bump stocks or support gun free school zones.

However, **Senators Bette Lasky** (D-Nashua), **Donna Soucy** (D-Manchester), **Lou D'Allesandro** (D-Manchester), and **Kevin Cavanaugh** (D-Manchester) all supported public safety with each vote they cast. *(Note: Cavanaugh was not yet elected during the vote on SB 12 and was absent during SB 357; D'Allesandro was absent during SB 492 vote.)*
